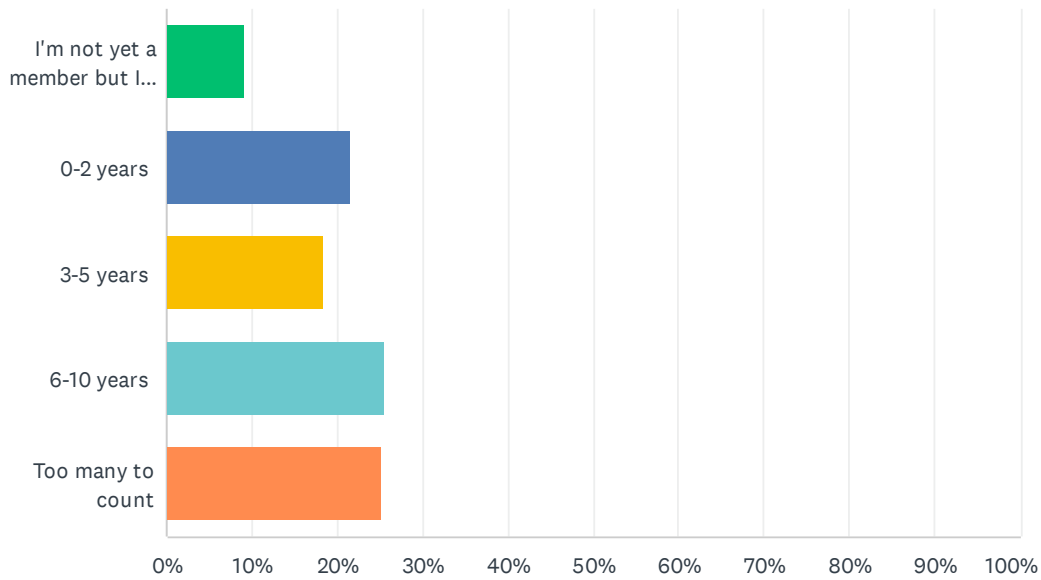

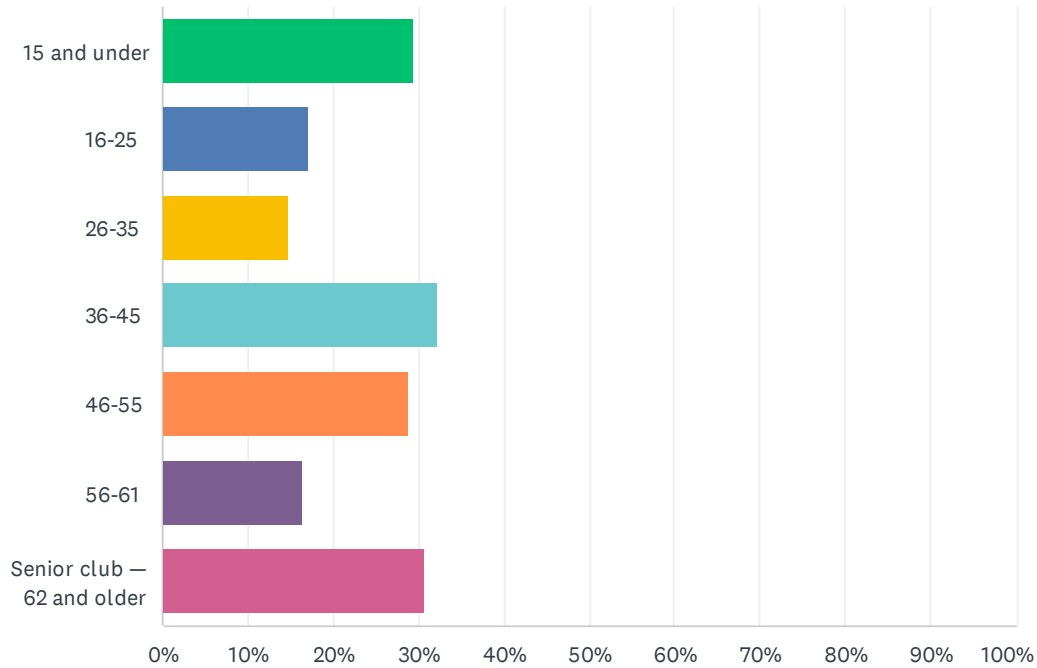

## Q2 What are the ages of trail users in your household? (Select all that apply)

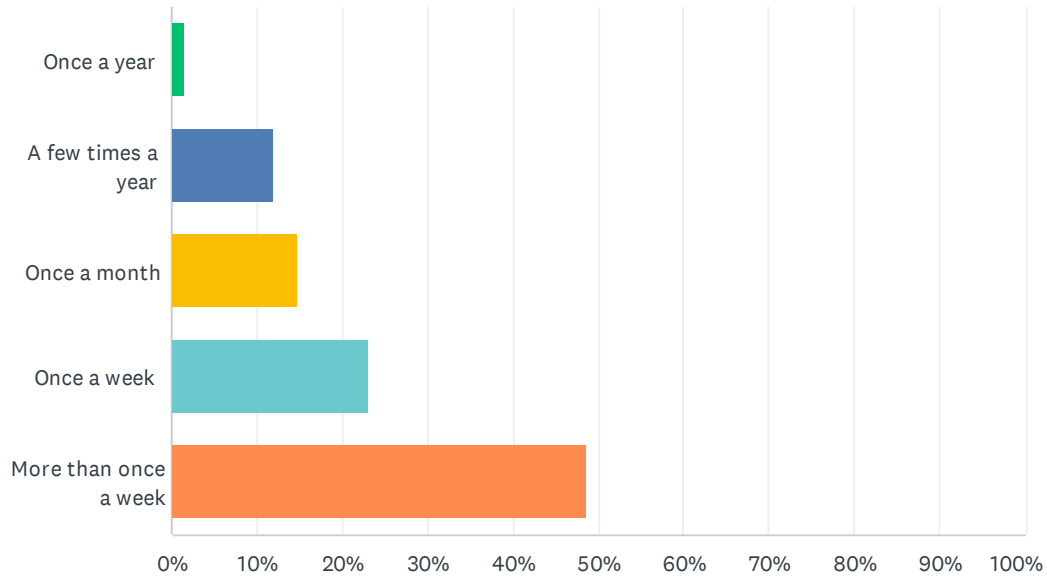

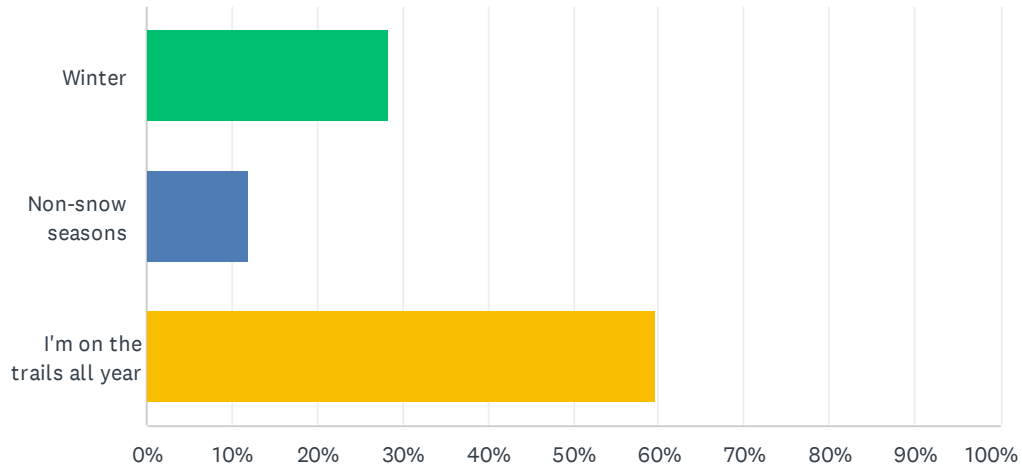

## Q4 In what season do you primarily use the trails?

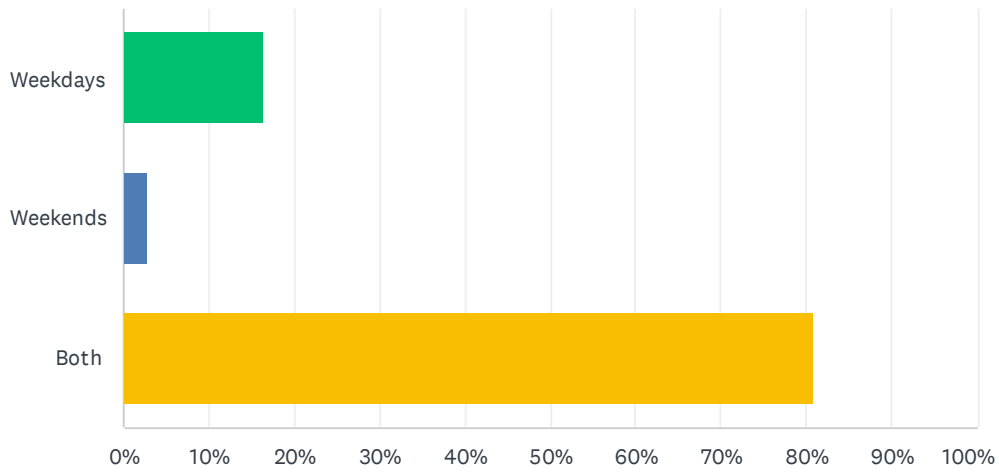

### Q5 Generally, when do you use the trails?

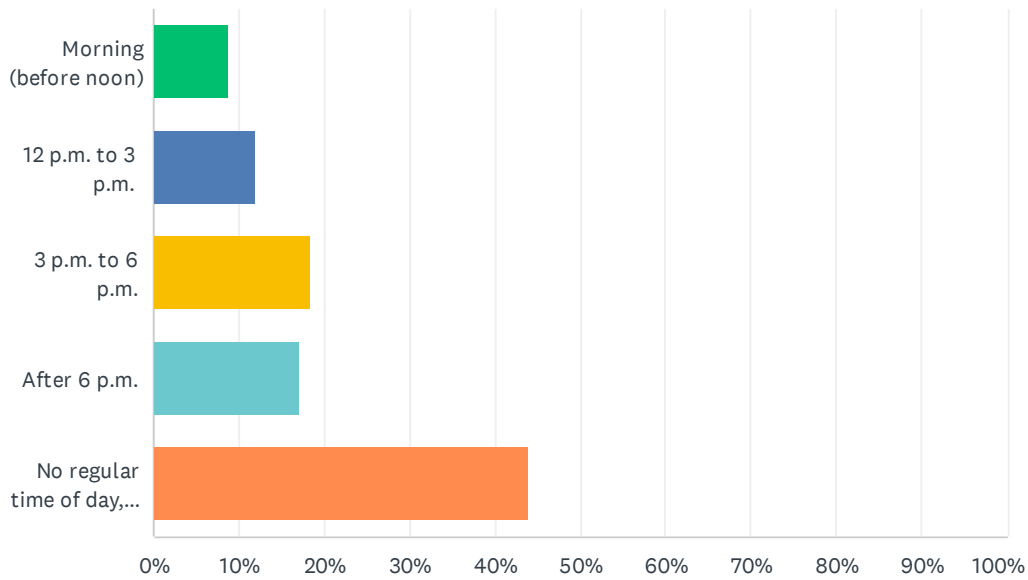

## Q6 Generally, what time of the day do you use the trails?

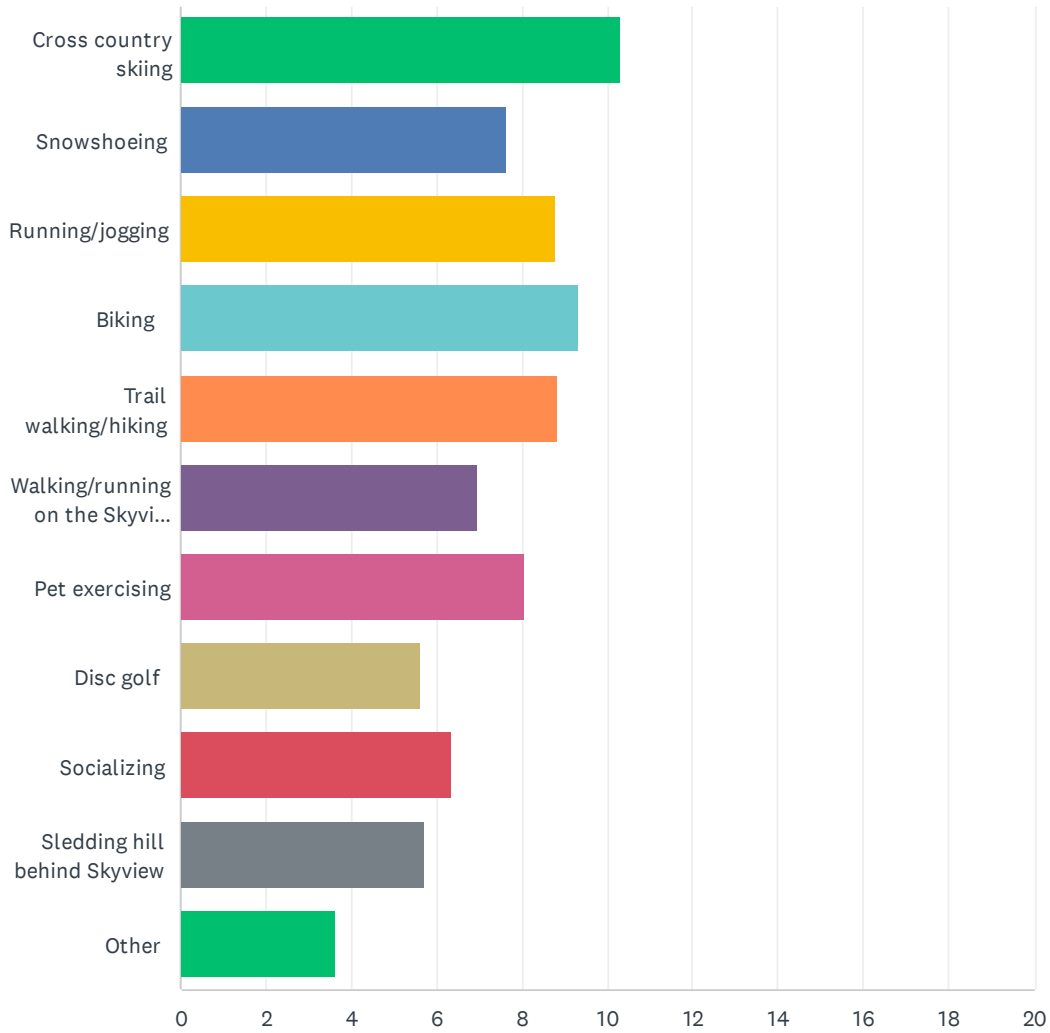

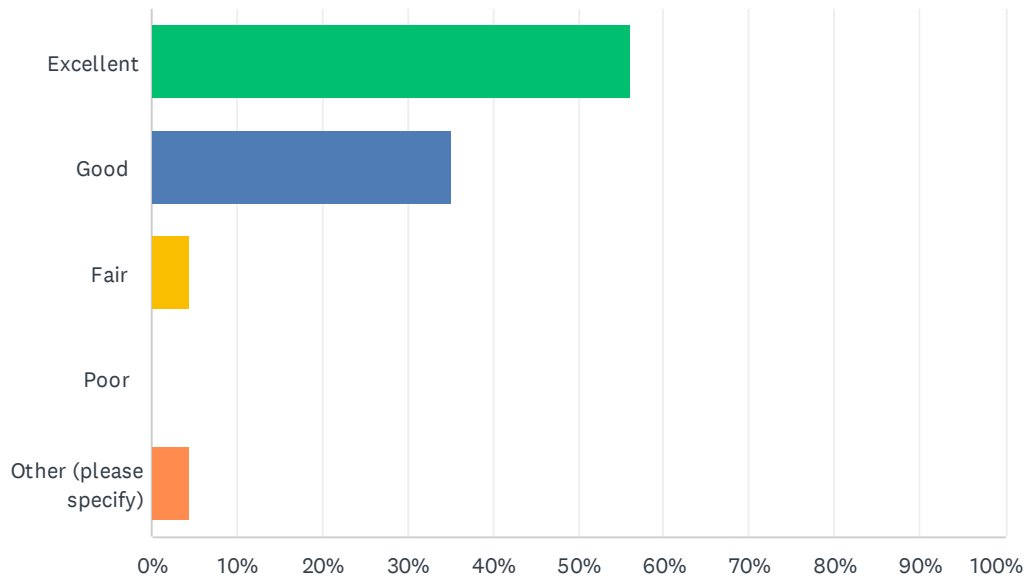

We need extensive packing of trails after heavy snowfall, especially the trail edges so classic skiing can be good quality and your poles are not punching through constantly because not enough continuous packing took place right after a big snow fall. Tracks should be laid everywhere, but many weeks went by this past season, where loops went ungroomed or no classic tracks were put in for quite awhile. Youth skiing, training and racing that takes place all over the state and on our Kenai Peninsula includes both classic and skating techniques so we need to do a better job with more consistent grooming for both techniques. People were told that Tsalteshi doesn't need more groomers, but yet when we head out for a weekend or weekday ski many times a fresh snowfall is ungroomed for a day or two. Why are we turning away people who are willing to volunteer when we don't keep our trails in top notch condition for our middle school and high school teams, community members, and many youth skiers. I also believe some training needs to take place so our groomers know the best way to pack a trail and what is best scenario for certain conditions. Get some training from Kincaid Park groomers or use local top skiers in the community for input. Ask what our groomers can do better so we can improve the trails. We even have Olympic x-country skiers that use the trails and live in our community that have a wealth of experience. Use these people and take feedback from them so we really can have some of the best trails in the nation, because I truly believe we can do much better. 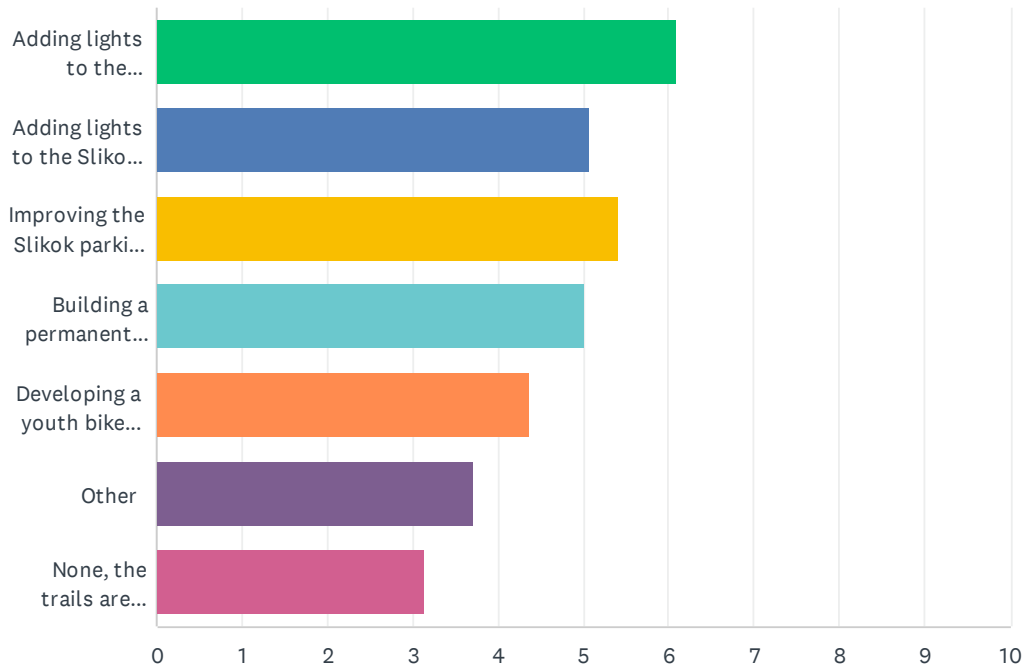

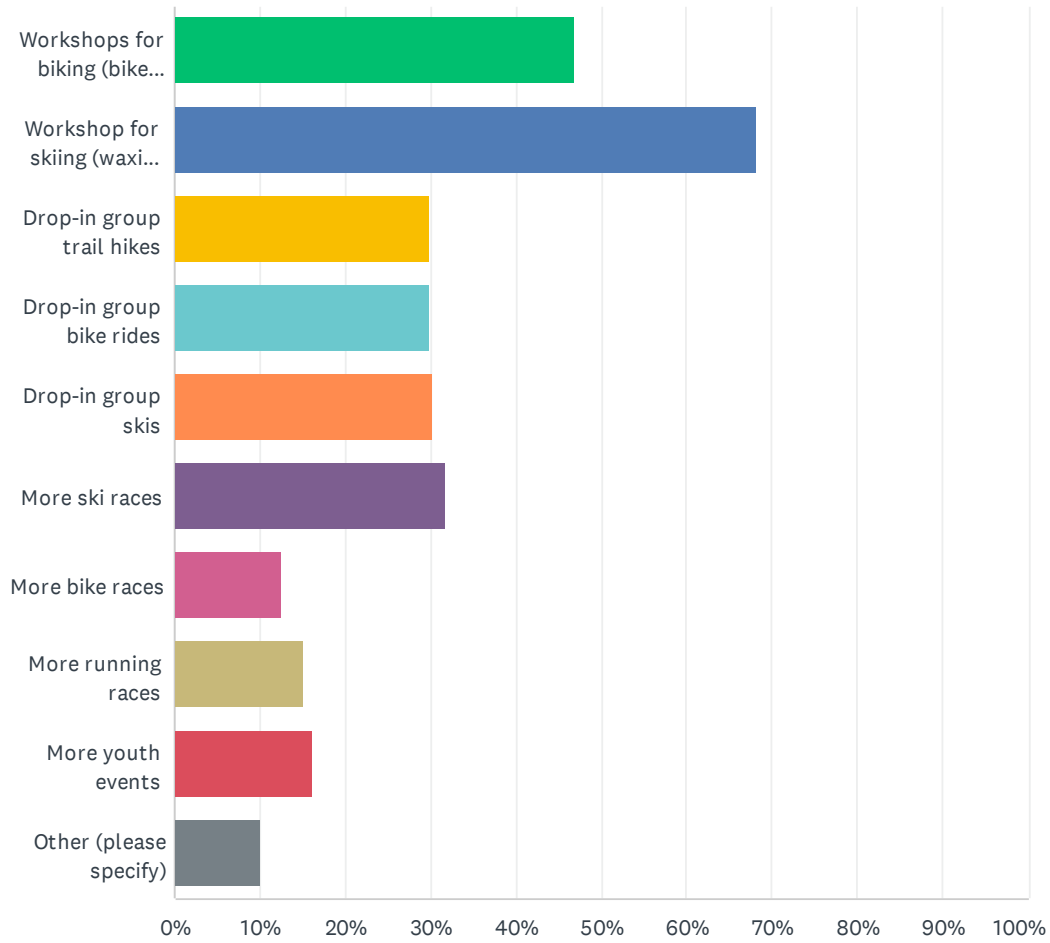

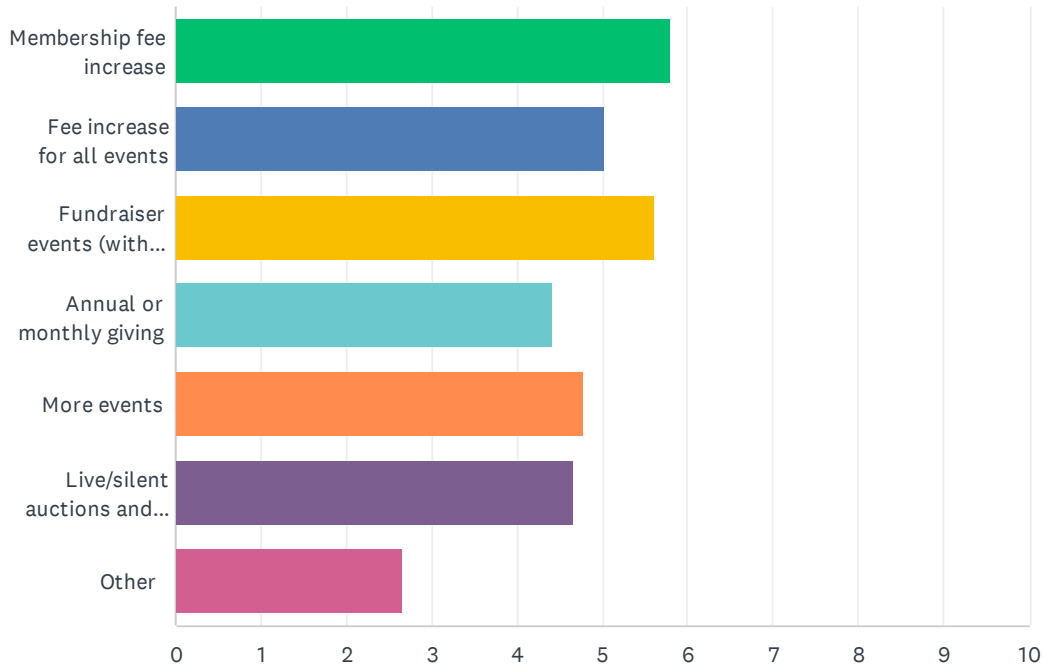
